#### **EDUCATION**

- 1,000+ learned English via ESOL Classes
- 217 individuals (87 families) improved their parenting skills through the Family Strengthening Program
- 100% of VPK-preschoolers ready for kindergarten
- 75% of middle school students improved grades/ attendance
- 79% of high school students improved reading

# Economic DEVELOPMENT

- 70% of participants acquired employment or a better job
- 70% of employed participants reduced debt and/or improved credit scores within 12 months
- Launched First Time Homebuyer Program
- 5,816 clients saved \$1.4M in tax preparation fees by receiving FREE tax preparation
- Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program created an economic impact of \$6.3M in tax refunds back to Broward County
- 663 adults learned how to start/strengthen their small business
- 300+ individuals participated in the 2016 Entrepreneur Summit

# Health & FAMILY CARE

- 2,170 individuals received nutrition education and food assistance
- 255 clients purchased a Qualified Health Plan with an annual savings of \$1.5M in health insurance premium savings
- 800 participants of Comprando Rico y Sano learned about healthy eating on a budget

#### Civic ENGAGEMENT

- 850+ applications were submitted for U.S. Citizenship
- 3,000 clients participated in Citizenship classes through Broward County Public Libraries (HUF partner)
- 260 clients attended intensive 8-week Pathways to Citizenship Classes




